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The Glorious Qur'an: A Book of Mercy for the Worlds

All praise is due to Allah, the Lord of all worlds, Who says in His Ever Glorious Book, "We send down the Quran as healing and mercy to those who believe," and said, "This is a blessed Scripture which We have sent down- follow it and be conscious of your Lord, so that you may receive mercy." I bear witness that there is no god but Allah, and that Muhammad is His Servant and Messenger. May Allah's Peace and Blessings be upon him, his Household, Companions and upon those who follow their path to the Day of Judgment.

The Qur'an is the firm means to bring us close to Allah. It is the best admonish, the light, and the straight path that may not be distorted, and that will be kept free from falsehood. Scholars will not cease to discover its marvelousness. It will never be outdated, and none can comprehend all its wisdom. Whoever speaks according to its verses will be truthful; whoever acts according to its guidance will be rewarded; whoever judges according to its provisions will be just; and whoever calls to it will be guided to a straight path. The Almighty Allah says, **"That this is truly a noble Quran; in a protected Record. That only the purified can touch; it is sent down from the Lord of all being.**" Allah also said, **"It is an unassailable Scripture; which falsehood cannot touch from any angle, a Revelation sent down from the Wise One, Worthy of All Praise**."

The Glorious Qur'an is a book of mercy for the worlds, as the Almighty Allah says, "O People! A teaching from your Lord has come to you, a healing for what is in [your] hearts, and guidance and mercy for the believers. Say [Prophet], 'In Allah's grace and mercy let them rejoice: these are better than all they accumulate." Allah Also said, "We have sent the Scripture down to you explaining everything, and as guidance and mercy and good news to those who devote themselves to Allah." In another verse, Allah said, "We have brought people a Scripture- We have explained it on the basis of true knowledge- as guidance and mercy for those who believe." The word "Mercy" and its derivatives are mentioned more than two hundred times in the Qur'an. The Glorious Qur'an states that mercy is one of the Attributes of Allah. Allah says, "My mercy encompasses all things." Allah also says, "Your Lord is self-sufficient and full of mercy." Allah also says, "Your Lord has taken it on Himself to be merciful."

When contemplating the Glorious Qur'an, one realizes the greatness of the mercy of Allah, the Almighty. Allah has created the day and the night as mercy for all His creatures, so that they may rest at night, and work by the day to get sustenance and to develop the universe. Allah also sends down rain as mercy for the worlds, as the Almighty Allah says, "In His mercy, He has given you night and day, so that you may rest and seek His bounty and be grateful." Allah also said, "It is Allah who sends the winds, bearing good news of His coming grace, and when they have gathered up the heavy clouds, We drive them to a dead land where We cause rain to fall, bringing out all kinds of crops, just as We shall bring out the dead. Will you not reflect."

The Glorious Qur'an states that Allah has sent down Messengers and revealed Scriptures as mercy to the worlds, as He (Glory be to Him) said, "You would say, 'If only the Scripture had been sent down to us, we would have been better guided than them.' Now clear evidence, guidance, and mercy have come to you from your Lord." Allah addressed His Prophet Muhammad saying, "We have not sent you except as mercy for the worlds." Allah also said, "A Messenger has come to you from among yourselves. Your suffering distresses him: he is deeply concerned for you and full of kindness and mercy towards the believers."

In the Qur'an, the Almighty Allah calls people to have hope in His mercy and forgiveness, showing that His mercy is near to the righteous people, as He said, "O My servants who have harmed yourselves by your own excess, do not despair of Allah's mercy. Allah forgives all sins: He is truly the Most Forgiving, the Most Merciful." Allah also said, "The mercy of Allah is close to those who do good."

All praise is due to Allah, Lord of the Worlds; may Allah's Peace and Blessings be upon him, his family, companions and whoever follows their guidance to the Day of Judgment.

It goes without saying that a true believer is the one who adopts the morals of the Glorious Qur'an which Allah has sent down ad mercy to the whole world, and follows the manners of the Prophet (PBUH) who was sent by Allah as mercy for mankind. The Prophet (PBUH) said, "The Compassionate One [i.e. Allah] has mercy on those who are merciful. If you show mercy to those who are on the earth, He Who is in the heaven will show mercy to you." The Prophet (PBUH) also said, "Allah divided Mercy into one hundred parts. He kept ninety-nine parts with Him and sent down one part to the earth, and because of that one single part, His Creations are merciful to each other, so that even the female horse lifts up its hoofs away from its baby animal, lest it should trample on it." It is reported that once a camel saw the Prophet (PBUH) and it wept tenderly producing yearning sound and it eyes flowed. The Prophet (PBUH) came to it and wiped the temple of its head. So it kept silence. He then said "Who is the master of this Camel? Whose Camel is this? A young man from the Ansar came and said "This is mine." He (PBUH) said "Do you not fear Allah about this beast which Allah has given in your possession. It has complained to me that you keep it hungry and load it heavily which fatigues it."

How much the whole humanity needs to follow the manners of Glorious Qur'an, the book of mercy and peace?!

We wish to conclude our speech with two pieces of advice: the first is to the people of the Qur'an, and the other to all the wise people of the world. We say to the people of the Qur'an, beautify the Qur'an with your nice voice and let the whole world listen to it. O the people of the Qur'an, perfect your good manners by following the morals of the Qur'an. Let your response to the ignorant who deny the status of the Book of your Lord by showing more care for the Glorious Qur'an, in terms of its recitation, study, understanding, application and action. O our Lord! We ask You to ward off all those who want to harm Your Book! O Allah, make their plots revert against them, and let us see Your power over them.

We say to all the wise people of the world that the world cannot witness religious wars in addition to the already running wars. So, take the initiative to renounce all kinds of religious hatred before it is too late, as extremism leads to counter-extremism. It is too bad to allow the fool to feed all feelings of religious hatred and destroy coexistence. There is no doubt that all enthusiastic Muslims are harmed by any abuse against their Prophet or the Book of their Lord. No matter how the wise people attain patience, time may come when they lose such patience, and the whole matter may turn into destructive troubles.
