Martyr's Day and the History of the Great Martyrs

Among those great martyrs is our master 'Amr Ibn al-Jamouh (may Allah be pleased with him), who was one of special abilities, as he had severe lameness. He had four sons who were fighting with our Prophet (PBUH) in the Battle of Uhud. He wanted to participate in the battle, but his four sons said, "Allah has excused you, and we will be instead of you." 'Amr said to the Prophet, "O Messenger of Allah, my sons do not allow me to go out for fighting with you, but I hope that I will be martyred and I hope that I will walk in the Paradise with this lame leg."! He was martyred in the battle, and the Prophet passed and said, "It is like I'm looking to you walking in the Paradise with your leg."

All praise is due to Allah, Lord of the Worlds; may Allah's Peace and Blessings be upon Prophet Muhammad (PBUH), his companions and followers:

The heroic actions of the great martyrs in the glorious history of our nation are witnessed in every generation.
